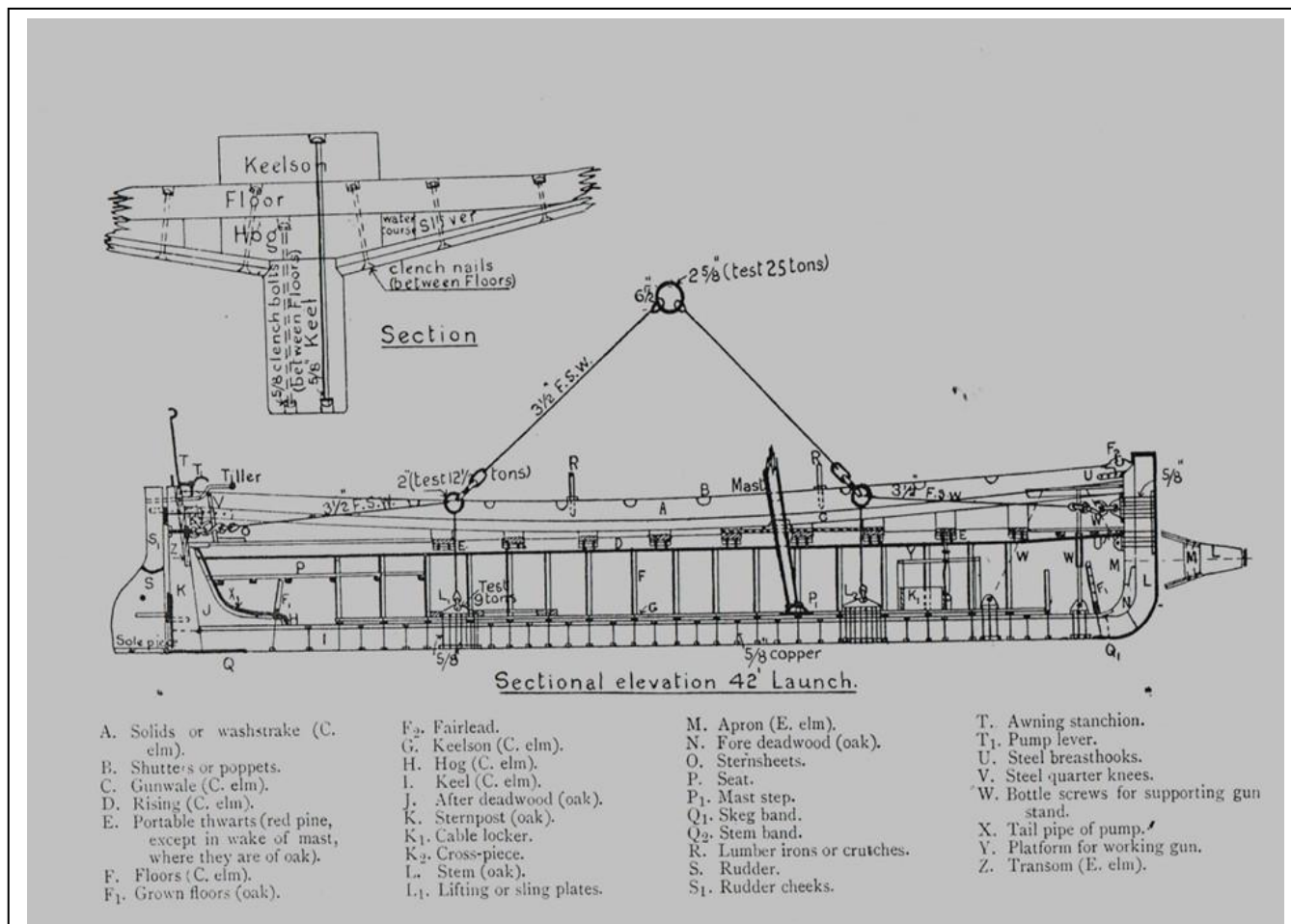


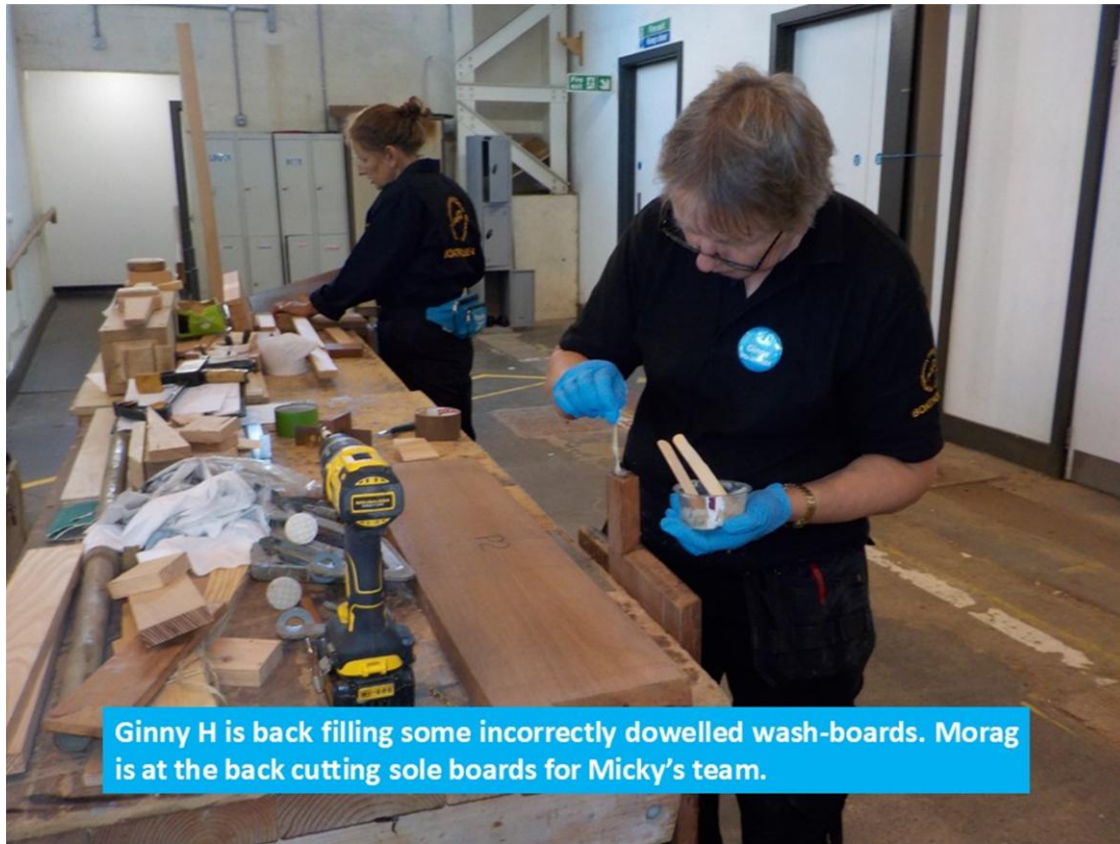


A summary of the work carried out in the Month of June 2026

The team had worked some pretty good magic on the boat before she was moved. Ginny had managed to work the whole way round the washboards and get then drilled and dowelled ready for the long term fit. Micky M and his team had worked their way nearly to the sharp end with the sole boards and the port side outer margin boards. Ros R and Trish G had made some good progress with the dummy oars and along with Ian P and Richard's full sized oar folding lofting floor we were getting a reasonable handle on the true size and shape of the oars. Since careening the hull over the teams have made significant progress with the hull below the waterline. All seams have been raked out and primed ready to take some splines.

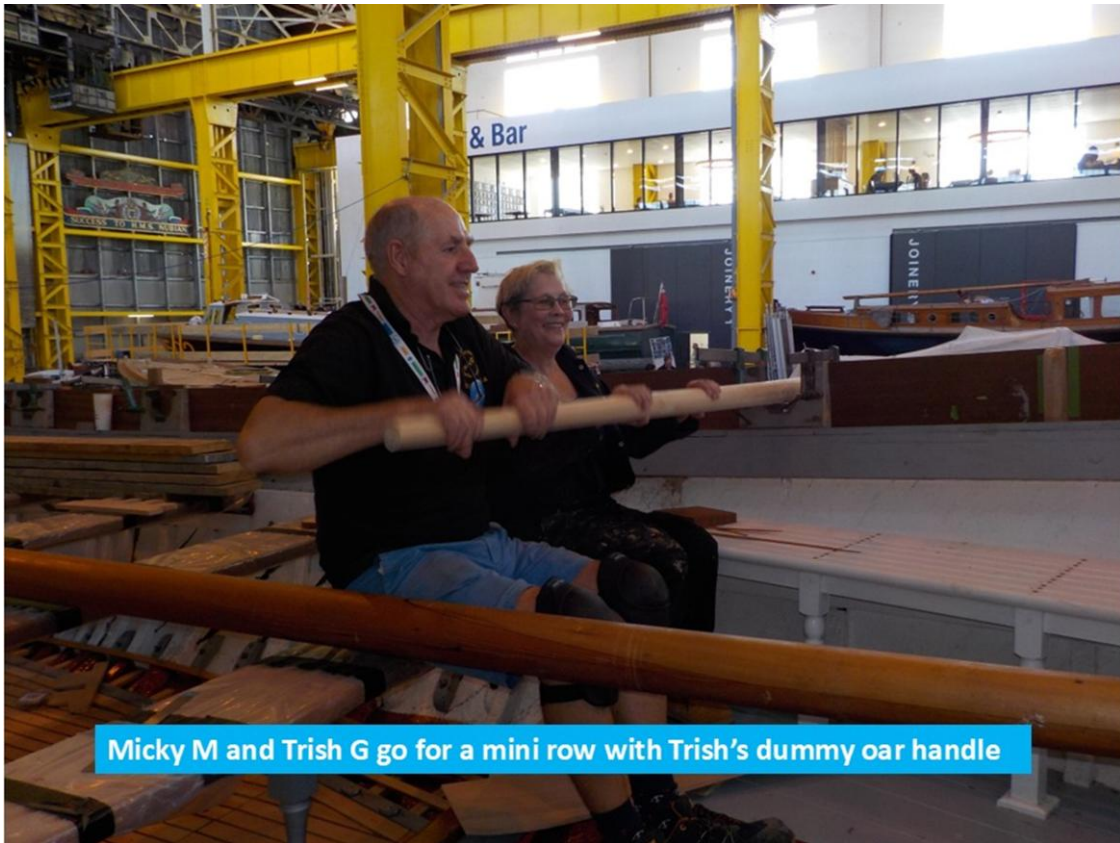

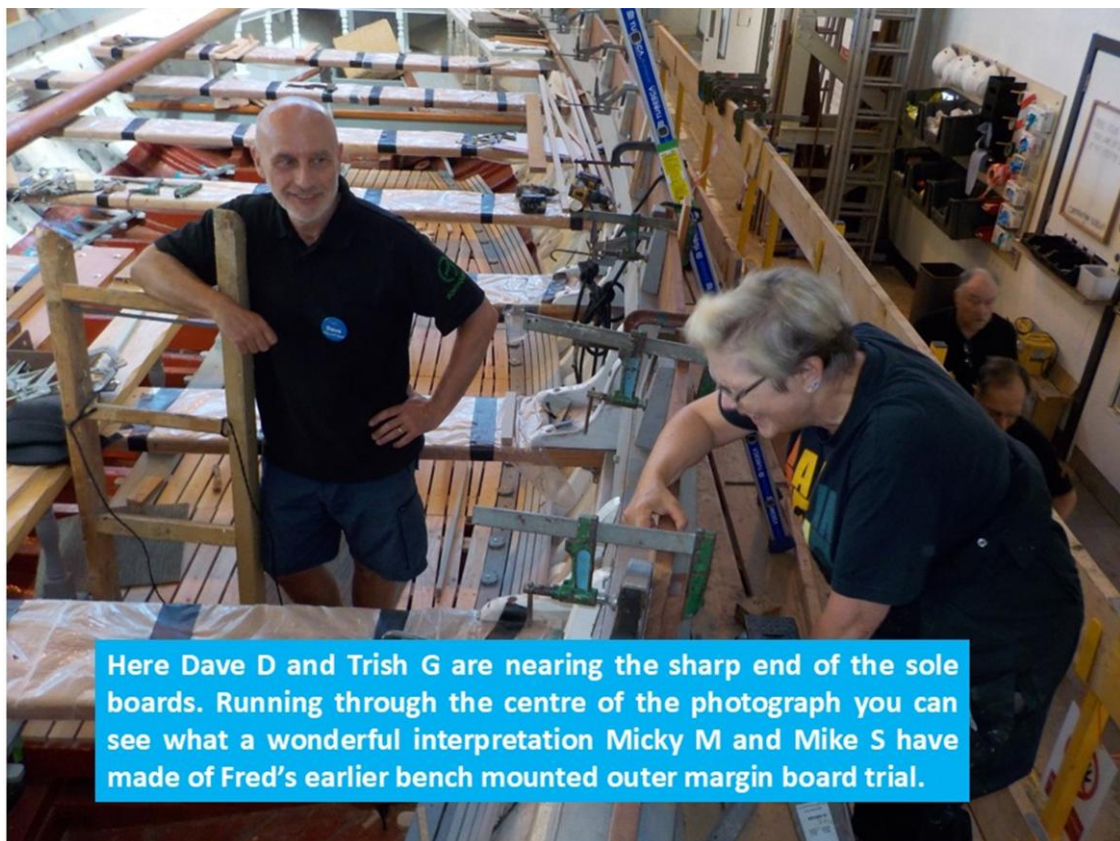

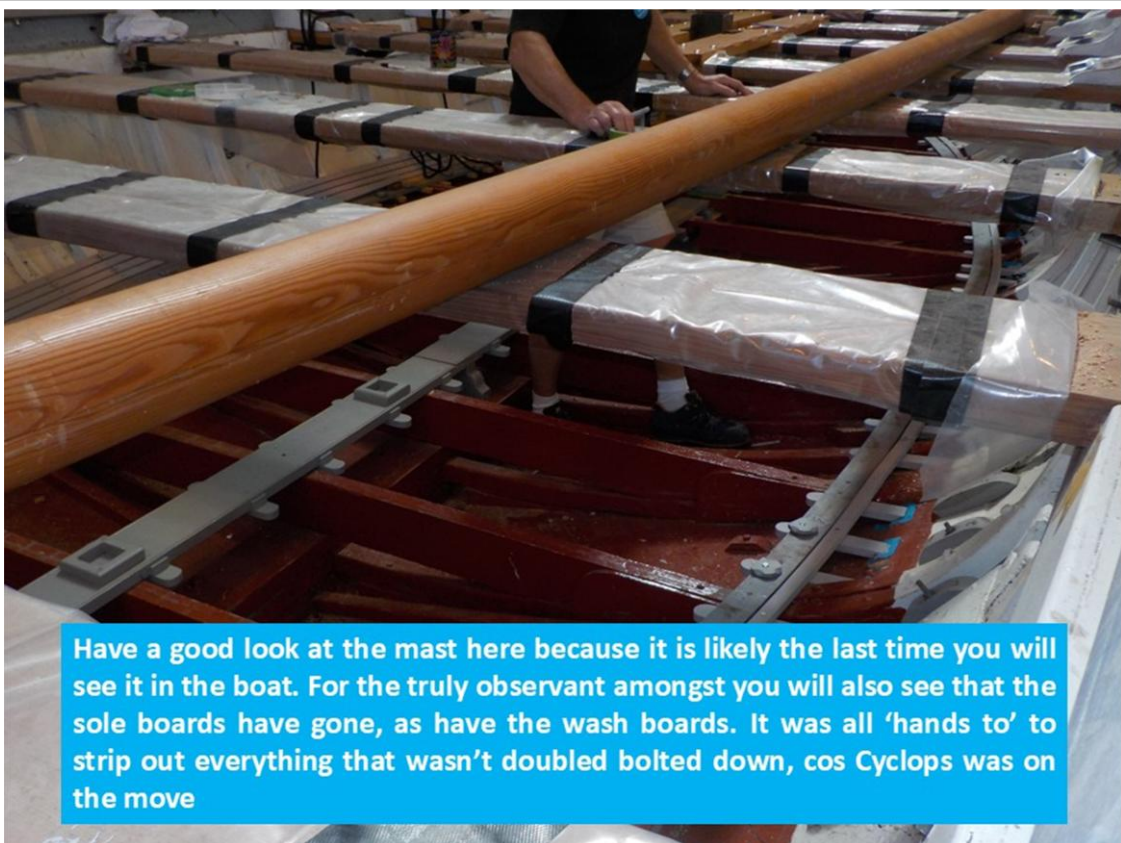


Micky M and Trish G go for a mini row with Trish's dummy oar handle

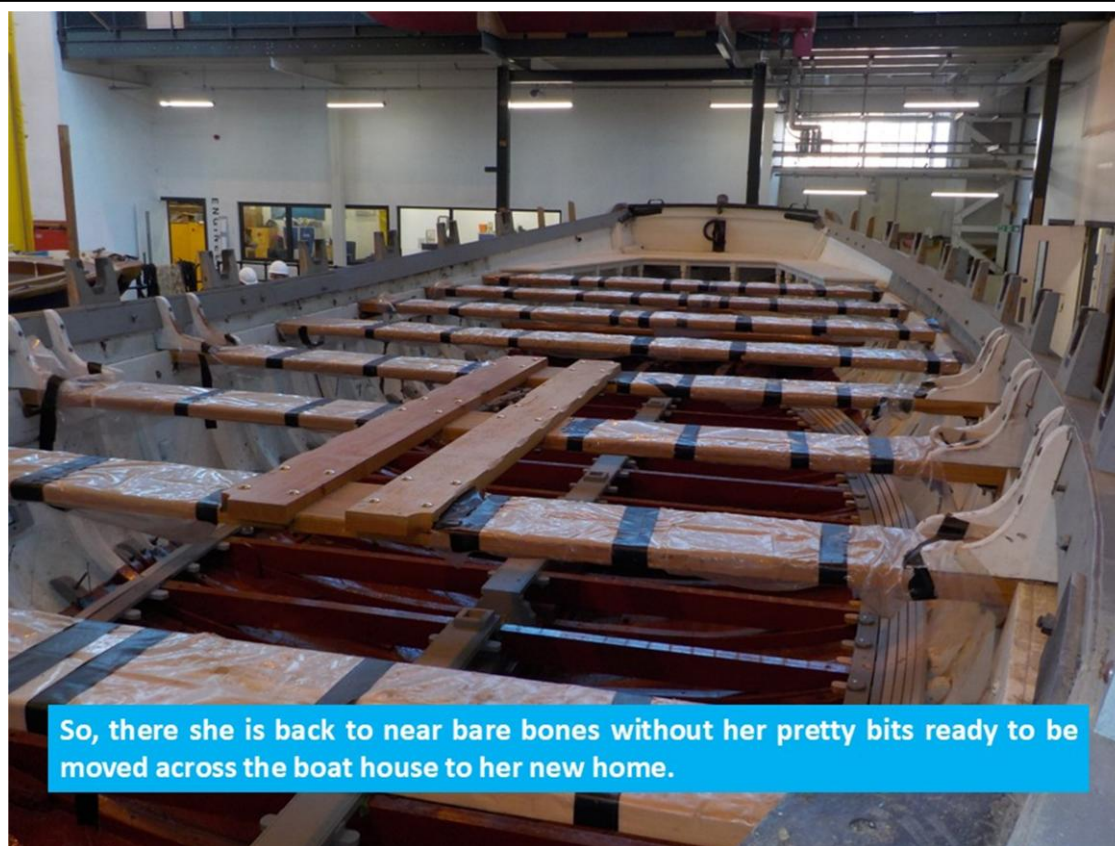

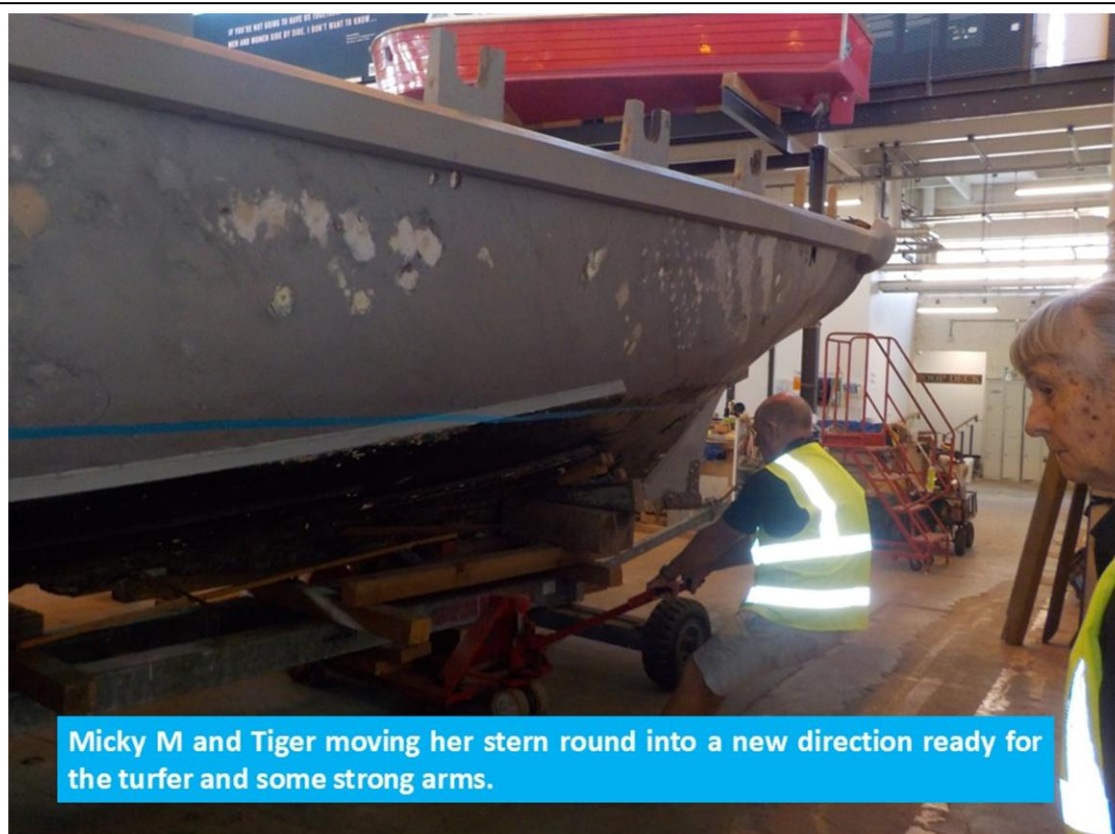

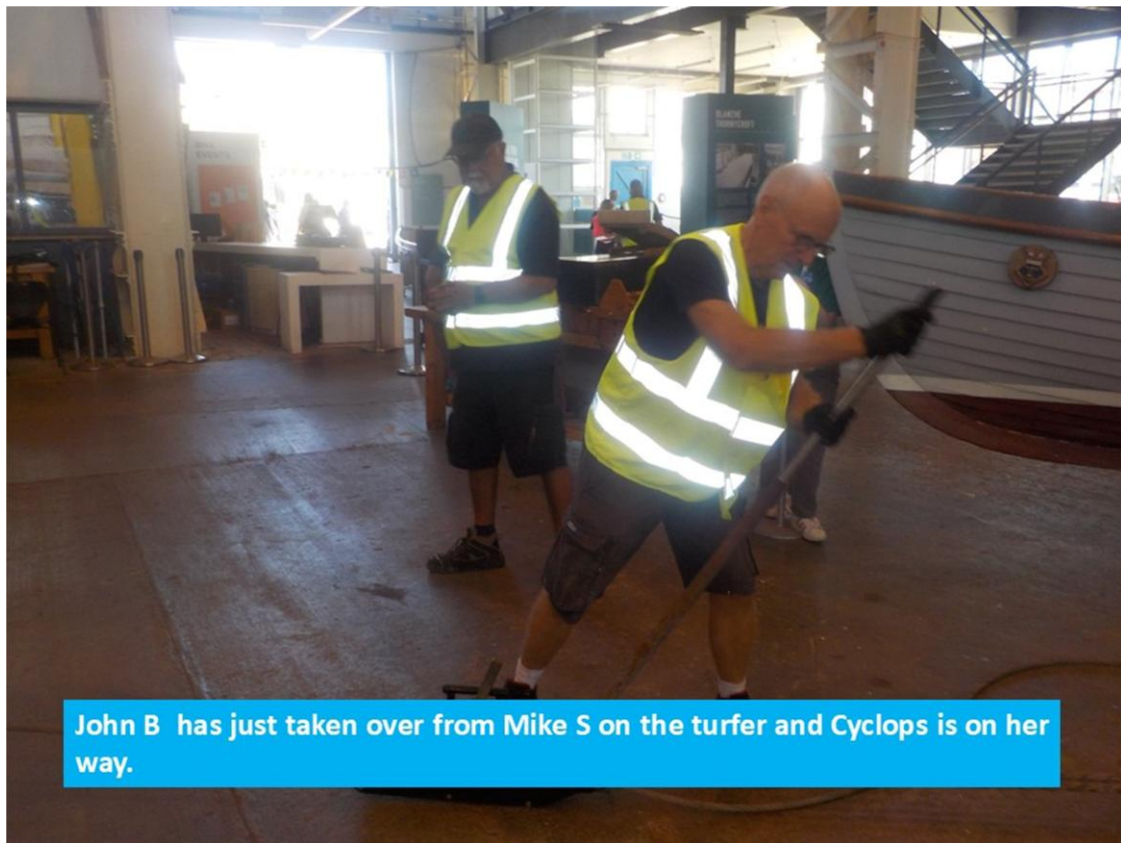


So, there she is back to near bare bones without her pretty bits ready to be moved across the boat house to her new home.

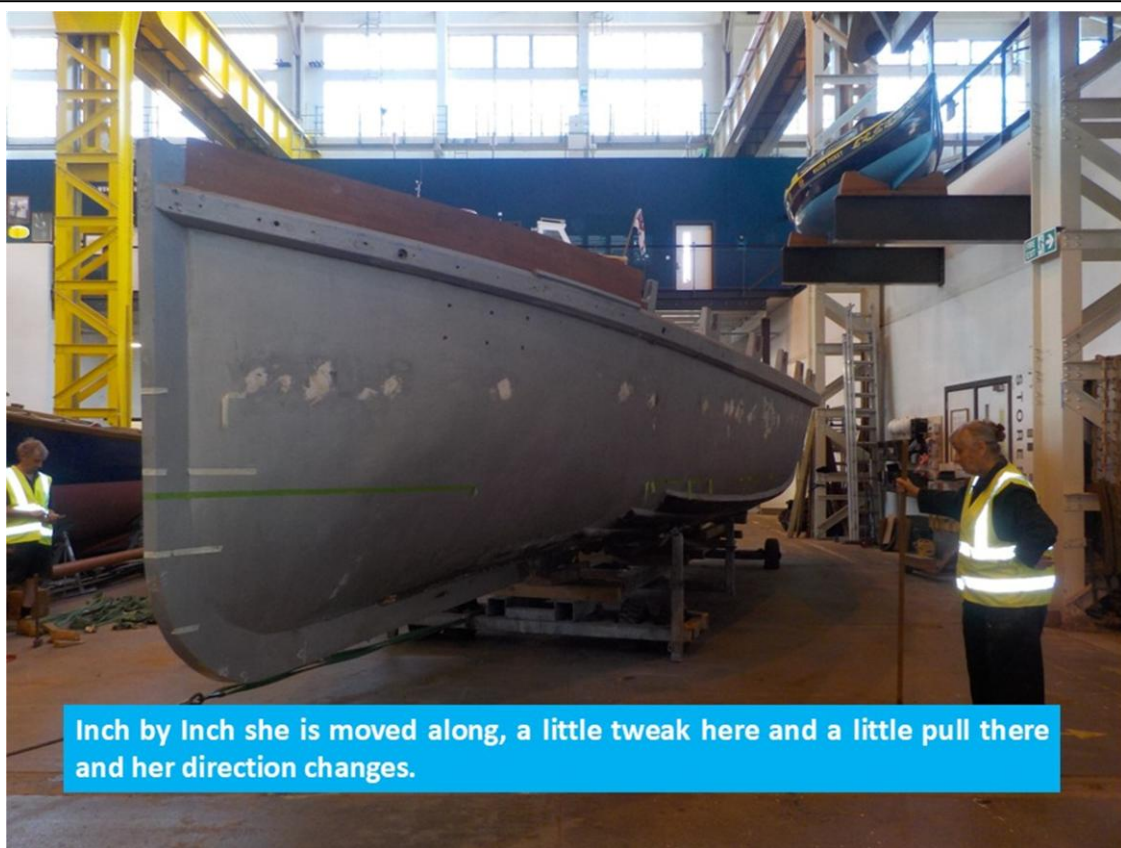


Micky M and Tiger moving her stern round into a new direction ready for the turfer and some strong arms.

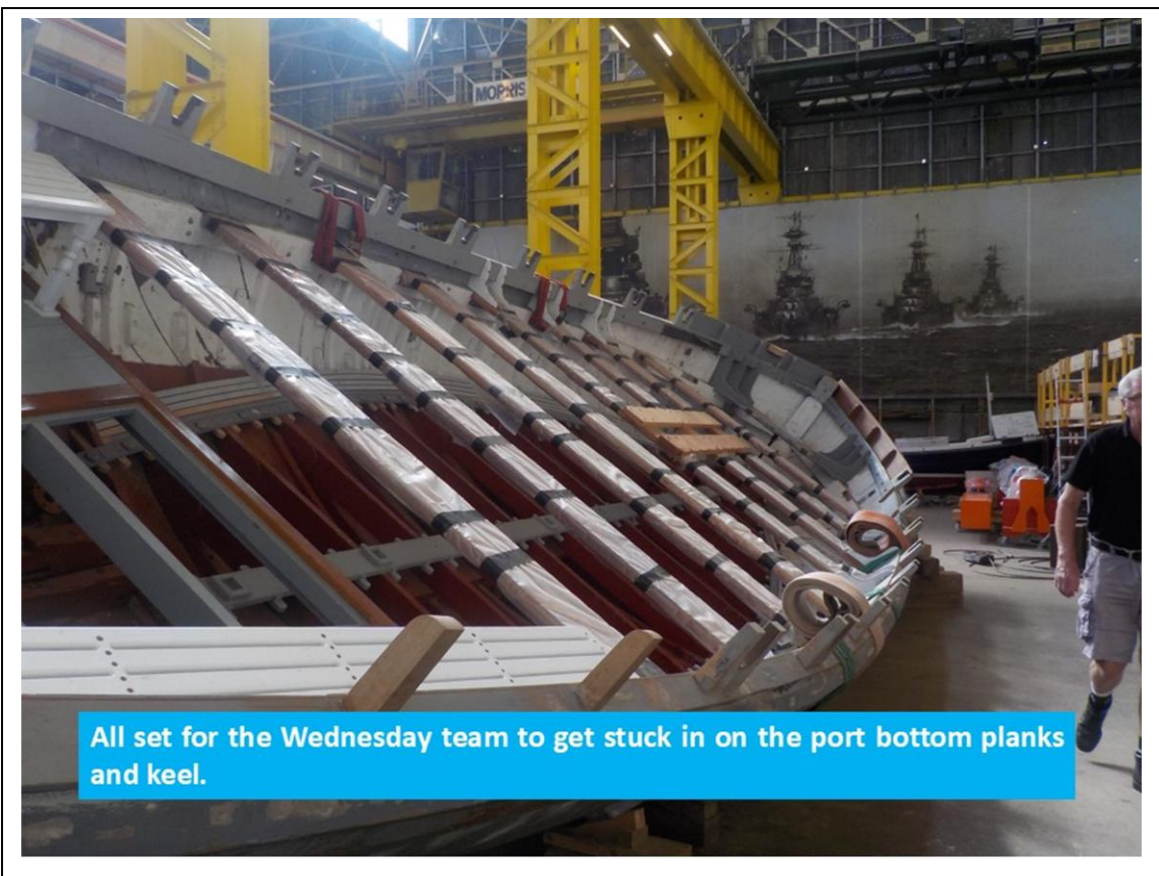
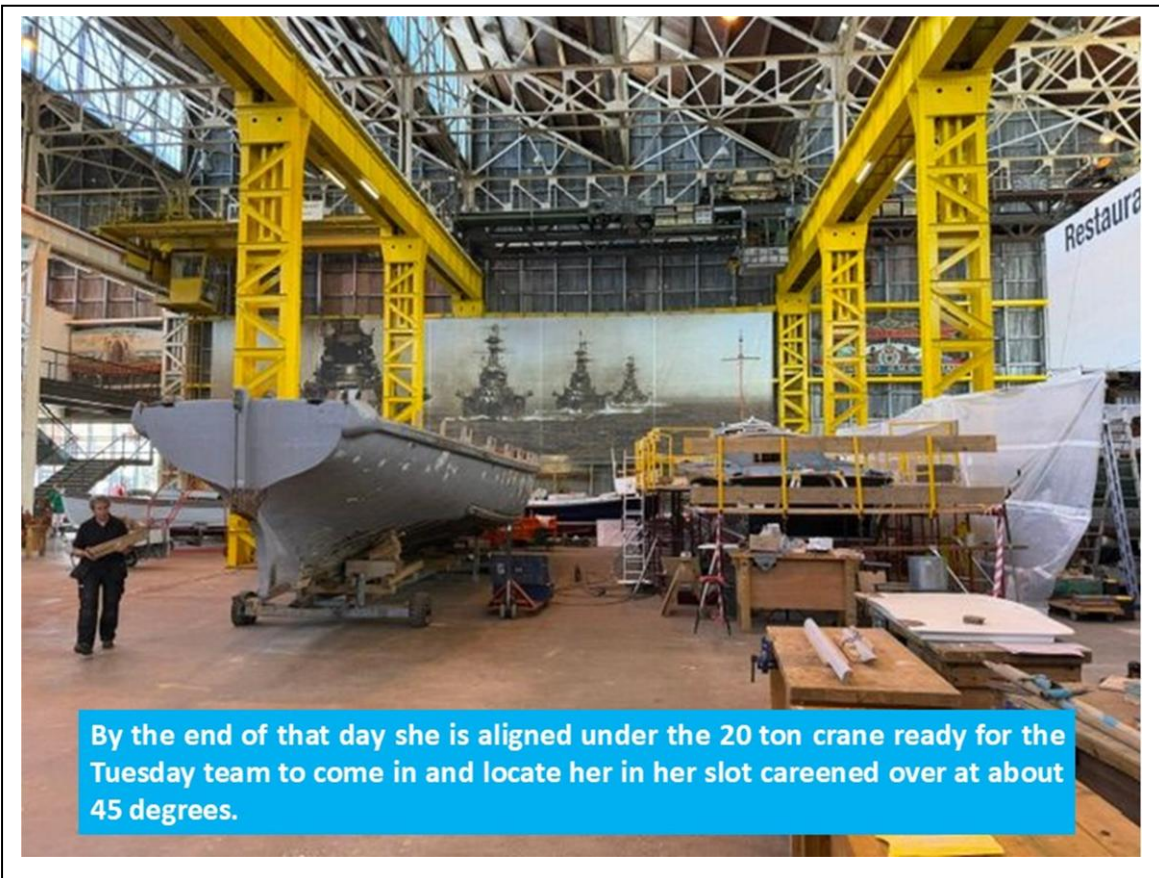
